

As you move into 3D animation, consider a demo reel rather than powerpoint.

Be careful starting with negative – I don't like powerpoint. It sends up a red flag you aren't flexible and/or willing to work with a particular program. Sometimes you don't get to choose the tools you work with and you must conform. And if you start with I don't like powerpoint, you are also implying you can do a better job with other tools. If you do so – back it up. Project board was a nice touch. However, be sure to take the time necessary to make a good project board – don't place papers on in a crooked manner, it implies you don't care.

Focus on the detail; take time to make the small things work.
