Putnam City Schools is beginning an ambitious after-school program in seven elementary schools this fall. The district is hiring 30 part-time people to engage and enrich students in grades 3, 4 and 5 as part of the Putnam City Make a Difference Program.

## The Basics

- Help children rise to their full potential in literacy, learning and life
- Serve your community, gain experience and learn essential skills
- Program lasts from Sept. 1, 2010, through July 31, 2011
- 2:30 to 6 p.m. each school day
- Living allowance of \$567.91 a month for 11 months
- When the 11-month commitment is completed, participants will receive an education stipend of \$2,675 that can be used to pay off qualified student loans or to finance college, graduate school or vocational training at eligible institutions
